RE: File number: notification R8007286 and tracking number 100487987 Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship (WLRS) has received your application for extending the existing residential dock to access deeper water. The work will be completed in two phases, as the District of Lake Country requires a variance for U-shaped dock configurations. Construction of the second phase will not proceed until the necessary approvals are obtained from the District. **Phase 1:** Extend the dock on the North side. **Phase 2:** Extend the dock south of the boatlift to create a U-shaped layout providing safer loading and unloading conditions for the boat at 15830 Whiskey Cove Road on Okanagan Lake
