Announcement:

On September 13, 2022, Prime Minister Trudeau announced that Monday, September 19, 2022 would be a holiday for federal government employees to mourn Queen Elizabeth II on the day of her state funeral. Subsequently, the Ministry of Education and Child Care informed Superintendents that B.C. would follow the lead of the federal government and join with other provinces in observing the national day of mourning to commemorate the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II. Therefore, all Central Okanagan Public Schools, Learning Centers, operations and business buildings will be closed on Monday, September 19, 2022.
