When you take down your natural Christmas tree after the holidays, dispose of it in an eco-friendly way and have it chipped for free! The RDCO Waste Reduction Office recommends giving your tree another life by dropping it off to be chipped and composted into a nutrient rich compost called



GlenGrow, available at various locations, including the Glenmore Landfill. Make sure to remove all decorations and tinsel before recycling your tree, plus any plastic bags or other materials used for transporting - all of these interfere with the composting process.
