#### 2. Public Hearing Statement

The Mayor opened the Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m.

The Mayor read the statement regarding the role of Council at a Public hearing. There were approximately 70 people in attendance.

#### 3. Zoning Amendment Bylaw 1245, 2024 | Z0000268 | 11511 Turtle Bay Court

#### 3.3 Public Comment

#### **Stephen Duke | Applicant**

The applicant addressed Mayor and Council regarding the proposed plan for the application.

The Mayor asked for a first time if there were any comments from the gallery.

#### Calvin Wiebe | Woodsdale Road

Mr. Wiebe believes Woodsdale Road is a poor location for a new hotel. His concerns include increased traffic and parking issues, a negative impact on the value and appeal of nearby properties and that the hotel would bring noise and disrupt the neighbourhood.

#### Ralph Rasmussen | Seymour Road

Mr. Rasmussen is concerned about the parking variance discussed by the developer. He worries that increasing the building height while reducing parking will exacerbate existing parking issues. He emphasizes that the hotel, along with a boat launch, will attract many visitors with trailers, and the current plan of one parking spot per sleeping unit is insufficient. He suggests that more parking spots per unit are necessary.

#### Lee McCarthy

Ms. McCarthy asked if environmental concerns have been considered, specifically regarding Vernon Creek. She echoed comments regarding parking of cars, boats, and trailers and asked Council to consider how this enhances the community for residents.

The Mayor asked for a second time if there were any comments from the gallery.

#### **Chris Evans | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Evans asked Council if traffic concerns are considered when hotels are proposed in Lake Country.

The Mayor asked for a third time if there were any comments from the gallery. No further comments were made.

The Mayor declared the Public Hearing for Zoning Amendment Bylaw 1245, 2024, Z0000268, 11511 Turtle Bay Court Closed at 7:17 p.m.

#### 4. Zoning Amendment Bylaw 1243, 2024 | Z0000339 | Strata Hotel / Motel Secondary Use

The Mayor opened the Public Hearing for Zoning Amendment Bylaw 1243, 2024, Z0000339, Strata Hotel/Motel Secondary Use at 7:18 p.m.

#### 4.3 Public Comment

#### Amir Hak | Applicant

The applicant gave a presentation regarding the plan for the proposed development.

#### **Grant Stevens | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Stevens expressed concerns about the proposed zoning amendment, emphasizing it represents a substantial change rather than a clarification. Mr. Stevens highlighted the importance of prioritizing housing for residents over tourist accommodations, noting the challenges faced by local businesses due to the lack of affordable housing for employees. He acknowledged the ambiguity surrounding the permitted number of units and stressed the negative impacts on the community, including parking issues and disruptions from short-term renters. Mr. Stevens argued the proposed development could lead to increased traffic, noise, and a decline in the quality of life for residents. He suggested Council should either turn down the proposed amendment or consider implementing a temporary use permit. This would allow for flexibility and further community feedback while providing a defined end period to assess the impact of short-term rentals. Mr. Stevens concluded by asking Council to consider the long-term needs of the community and the potential consequences of the rezoning decision, advocating for a cautious and well-considered approach.

#### **Robert Heiss | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Heiss discussed the zoning amendment for the Zara Development, emphasizing the need for adjustments to the master plan. Originally, the plan included a golf course, vineyards, and a lakeside hotel, but by 2012, these were replaced with various housing types and short-term rentals. Mr. Heiss criticized the introduction of short-term rentals in a neighbourhood lacking tourism amenities and supportive facilities, arguing that the term "resort" is misleading given the removal of key resort features. Mr. Heiss highlighted the inconsistency in the development's evolution, noting that single-family homes now dominate the area, with a condo building introduced in the middle. They questioned the suitability of short-term rentals in this context and suggested that both the developer and local planning authorities failed to consider the changing needs of the community, particularly the increased demand for long-term housing. Mr. Heiss urged Council to prioritize long-term strategic planning for tourism accommodation and recommended turning down the zoning amendment to correct past mistakes and support the community's housing needs, allowing for 30-day-plus rentals that align with existing zoning regulations.

#### John Tait | Benchland Drive

Mr. Tait expressed concerns about the proposed zoning amendment. He highlighted the uncertainty and lack of transparency from the developer, noting that when they purchased their home in 2019, they were assured it would be a three or four-story condominium with some short-term rentals, not a six-story hotel. Mr. Tait emphasized the negative impact of the construction, including parking and noise issues, and the extended construction time due to the increased height. He noted the developer did not engage with the community enough or address their concerns. Mr. Tait stressed short-term rentals would change the character of the neighbourhood, leading to more policing

and bylaw issues. Mr. Tait urged Council to defer the decision to gather more information and consider the long-term benefits of having full-time owners or renters, which would foster a happier and more stable neighbourhood.

#### Kelley Marko | Beacon Hill Drive

Ms. Marko opposes the proposed zoning amendment arguing it prioritizes short-term tourist accommodations over long-term residential housing. Ms. Marko believes the change is intended to bypass the Short Term Rental Accommodations Act and contradicts provincial and municipal goals of increasing long-term housing . She highlighted that the entire property could become a fully functioning hotel if unit owners choose, leading to decisions driven by profit maximization, which would negatively impact the neighbourhood. Ms. Marko raised concerns about increased noise and traffic, noting that sound is amplified in their area and short-term renters are less likely to be considerate. She emphasized that transient hotel occupants would disrupt the residential nature of Lakestone and urged Council to deny the zoning application to protect the neighbourhood's character and ensure long-term housing availability.

#### Lyle Shrigley | Benchlands

Mr. Shrigley owns two units in Zara and expressed frustration regarding the zoning amendment which contradicts his initial understanding of the development. He highlighted concerns about the impact on the community, including potential noise and disruption from transient guests. Mr. Shrigley emphasized he did not invest in the property to tolerate large groups of tourists and the associated wear and tear on the building. He urged Council to reject the zoning change to preserve the quality and intent of the original development.

#### Lynn Haley | Benchland Court

Ms. Haley expressed concerns about the zoning amendment emphasizing the development has continually changed from the original plan of a three-story condo to a six-story building with potential short-term rentals. Ms. Haley stressed short-term rentals would lead to increased noise, traffic, and parking issues, disrupting the community's character and livability. She urged Council to decline the zoning amendment and focus on long-term rentals to align better with the community's needs. Ms. Haley posed the question of the benefits of short-term rentals versus long-term contributions to the community and highlighted the need for a well-laid-out proposal for any future hotel locations.

#### France Lefebvre | Benchland Drive

Ms. Lefebvre expressed her opposition to the zoning amendment. She highlighted the prolonged construction time and the change in contractors, questioning the viability of running a short-term rental operation without public transportation. She emphasized feeling deceived by the developer and urged Council to consider the long-term impact of their decisions on the community.

#### Kim Ogrodnick | Centrestone Drive

Ms. Ogrodnick expressed concerns regarding the proposed zoning change for Zara at Lakestone. She noted that the development was initially marketed as a luxury condominium, but recent changes suggest it could become a hotel, which represents a significant shift. Ms. Ogrodnick highlighted the potential negative impacts of short-term rentals, including increased insurance costs, bylaw enforcement issues, and parking problems. She emphasized that the community is worried about the long-term effects on their quality of life and the neighbourhood's character. She urged Council to consider the potential lasting impact of their decision, advocating for maintaining the original vision of the development to preserve the community's essence.

#### **Chris Evans | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Evans expressed concerns about the proposed zoning amendment for Zara at Lakestone. He emphasized the area's prestige and safety, which attracted his family to the neighbourhood. Mr. Evans highlighted the community's investment in Lake Country and the potential negative impact of transient visitors on the neighbourhood's character and safety. He urged Council to consider the long-term residents who support the community daily and to make a decision that preserves the area's integrity.

#### Mandy Bains | Long Road

Ms. Baines highlighted the District's restriction on registering home businesses in Lakestone to maintain a quiet neighbourhood. She pointed out allowing the proposed hotel would contradict this goal, leading to increased activity and noise. Ms. Bains suggested if the hotel is approved, residents should also be allowed to register home businesses, as the neighbourhood's quiet nature would already be compromised. She emphasized the vision for Lakestone was a peaceful, semi-retired community, which would be lost with the zoning change.

#### Patti Ahl | Okanagan Centre Road West

Ms. Ahl expressed concerns about the negative changes brought by additional development. She emphasized temporary visitors do not share the same pride and care for the neighbourhood as permanent residents. Ms. Ahl highlighted ongoing issues such as garbage and fires from beach parties, which bylaws cannot keep up with. She urged the Council to consider the impact on the community and maintain the neighbourhood's integrity by rejecting the proposed changes.

#### **Bruce McAuliffe | Ledgestone Road**

Bruce McAuliffe expressed concerns about the proposed zoning amendment, emphasizing the area is a residential community, not a resort. He highlighted the significant changes since the original 2012 plan and the need for long-term rentals to address the housing shortage. Mr. McAuliffe shared personal experiences, including his son's struggle to find affordable housing, and stressed the importance of maintaining the community's character. He urged Council to focus on long-term benefits and consider the impact of their decisions on the community's future.

The Mayor asked for a second time if there were any comments from the gallery.

#### **Grant Stevens | Benchland Drive**

In conclusion, Mr. Stevens urged Council to consider the long-term impact of their decision on the community, emphasizing the need to look ahead to 2026 and beyond. He pointed out that while the developer will leave after selling the units, the residents will remain. Mr. Stevens encouraged Council to make a decision benefitting the long-term well-being of the area.

The Mayor asked for a third time if there were any comments from the gallery.

#### **Chris Evans | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Evans expressed concerns about the potential devaluation of his property if the zoning amendment proceeds. They highlighted the difficulty of selling their home in the future if the area becomes undesirable due to the new development. Mr. Evans emphasized the hard work they have put into paying off their mortgage and the impact this change could have on their family's financial stability. They urged the Council to consider the long-term effects on property values and the community's ability to sell their homes.

#### **Gaye Harris | Centrestone Drive**

Ms. Harris expressed concerns about the impact of the proposed hotel on the

community. She highlighted that the area was chosen for its quiet, residential nature, which would be disrupted by transient visitors. Ms. Harris identified current parking issues resulting from construction and the potential for increased parking problems if short-term rentals are allowed. She emphasized residents are not permitted to rent their homes for less than 30 days, and allowing Zara to have short-term rentals would be unfair and detrimental to the neighbourhood's character. Ms. Harris urged Council to consider the community's concerns and maintain the area's integrity.

#### **Jamie Tretiak | Centrestone Drive**

Ms. Tretiak moved to Lakestone seeking a safe, community-oriented environment after experiencing issues with transient rentals in McKinley Beach. Ms. Trentiak emphasized the importance of knowing her neighbours and maintaining a quiet, family-friendly neighbourhood. She expressed fears about the return of short-term rentals, which could lead to increased crime and a decline in property values. Despite rising mortgage rates, she chose to stay in Lakestone for its community feel and urged Council to consider the long-term impact on residents.

#### **Dean Sutton | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Sutton highlighted the potential negative impact on property values and quality of life. Mr. Sutton noted that the development feels disorganized and lacks proper communication, reinforcing that both long-term residents and new families are deeply concerned about the changes. He urged Council to consider the significant effects on the community and prioritize the residents' well-being over the developer's objectives

#### **Glenn Carnegie | Benchland Drive**

Mr. Carnegie emphasized when his family bought their home they were told the development would be a luxury four-story condo, not a short-term rental property. Mr. Carnegie highlighted the importance of community and the negative impact visitors would have, including parking issues and overcrowded amenities like pickleball courts. He stressed property values would likely decrease and long-term rentals would be more acceptable, as they foster a sense of community. He urged Council to reject the proposal to maintain the neighbourhood's integrity.

The Mayor asked for a third time if there were any comments from the gallery. There were none.

#### Amir Hak | Applicant

The applicant gave closing remarks and responded to questions from Council.

The STR option was integral to my decision, as Zara was zoned and marketed as a short-term rental property exempt from BC's speculation and vacancy tax. Without this STR option, I would not have purchased the unit. The government reversal on this zoning and exemption undermines the fundamental assurances that made this investment viable. Had I known STRs and the tax exemption would be at risk, I would not have proceeded with the purchase.

The ability to occasionally rent my unit is crucial for offsetting my mortgage costs especially in this higher interest rate environment. This flexibility makes ownership affordable for families like mine, who rely on STR income to subsidize such investments. Many owners, including myself, would be forced to sell if this flexibility were removed, as long-term rental income does not meet the financial model initially considered.

Purchasing this vacation property has placed undue stress on my family. After scraping together a down payment during COVID, we are not only contending with ongoing delays but are now forced to fight to retain the short-term rental option we were initially promised. This reversal is especially disheartening given the economic boost STR guests would bring to Lake Country's economy. With Okanagan tourism already down by 30%, it's hard to understand the rationale—especially since this project was initially supported by both the community and the district. I question why we must now fight for what was originally promised to us.

The fairest solution would be to grandfather Zara at Lakestone, preserving its STR designation as originally zoned and marketed. This would honour the commitments made to buyers and avoid significant financial impacts on current owners. Given that the project was approved and marketed as STR-friendly, reversing this decision now feels contrary to the principles of due process and transparency. I believe that allowing Zara to retain its STR status would make it an ideal test case and a valuable case study for future STR projects, helping to inform and guide policy decisions moving forward.

Thank you for considering the concerns of Zara owners. I hope the Planning Department will take these factors into account and allow Zara at Lakestone to retain its STR designation.

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### Change.Org Petition Text.

I, as a concerned citizen of the District of Lake Country, call upon the DLC Council to decline the Zoning Amendment application (Zoning Amendment Bylaw 1243, 2024) to amend the DC3 - Direct Control 3 zone (Lakestone) to add a Secondary Use as "Strata Hotel/Motel".

With this Zoning Amendment the Zara developer Dominium Real Estate Developments of Calgary Alberta has found a work-around to B.C. Government legislation which is meant to provide much needed long term rental housing.

This will directly impact much needed access to long term rentals in Lake Country. It will detrimentally affect the family friendly neighborhood character of the residents of Lakestone and surrounding areas. It will also add markedly increased traffic pressure on the OK Centre Road / Glenmore intersection a location which is currently woefully inadequate.

With vacation rental guest units located right in the middle of single family unit homes, these surrounding homes will experience increased noise, parking and safety concerns. There will be increased pressure on inadequate traffic infrastructure (Glenmore Road intersection); increased strain on RCMP and by-law enforcement resources due to inappropriate location. By allowing rentals in Zara as short term, much needed long term rentals will have been removed from a market in a community already suffering from a shortage.

In a time when there is a great demand for long term rentals the District of Lake Country has chosen to keep rental units as short term rental, one may question who this benefits most. The Zara building owner Dominium Developments has found a work-around to Gov't of B.C legislation and is now requesting that the local Gov't support this questionable action. If this amendement is passed there is a very real possibility that Zara will become a full fledged tourist hotel In the middle of a residential area resulting in the loss of a beautiful quiet family friendly neighborhood that many new residents have come to call home.

As the District of Lake Country Council is about to vote approval of this zoning change Nov 5th, now is the time we need as many residents as possible to sign this petition.
